Children will read from decodable texts from previously taught units with a focus on Word Reading and Comprehension Skills . Writing: Content from at least two units behind the current unit.					
Reading and Writing Opportunities	Six carefully chosen key texts (1 per half term) are selected through the year that drive the curriculum with a focus on reading and writing in both Adult Led Sessions and Child Initiated Play. Daily Story times develop a 'love of reading' with children independently selecting their favourite stories to share.
